I. Conference Goal

The Second International Conference on Financial Literacy 2026 aims to offer a platform for reflection, training, and exchange of ideas about the main lines of research on financial literacy.

This conference will serve as a forum for discussing financial literacy research initiatives with both, theoretical and practical implications. Among the main topics for the conference are, but not limited to, the following:

III. Important dates

- Deadline for papers and posters: **31 August 2026**
- Registration deadline: 23 October 2026

IV. Participation types

a) Research Papers (Virtual presentation)

A maximum of three authors may be included in theoretical or empirical papers, recently published or unpublished (the latter with the potential to be published in an e-book with ISBN if the author authorizes it.). To be accepted, received works will undergo a double-blind peer review process.

Those interested should send two documents to ucc.flrc@ucc.mx pursuant the following guidelines:

1. Cover page: Title of the research, full name of the authors, institutional affiliation, and email address. Please point out the corresponding author.
2. Research work: Title of the research; an abstract of no more than 200 words; keywords (maximum of 4); and the full paper in Word format, with a maximum length of 25 pages, using Times New Roman font, 12-point size, and double line spacing. References (APA 7) preferably from the last five years.

b) Posters (In-person)

The poster presentation, a visual description of a research project by undergraduate or graduate students—will be presented at Universidad Cristóbal Colón's Campus Calasanz. Presenters are going to share their findings with the audience through concise and careful explanation. It is an easy format to show a short study presentation and at the same time, it facilitates an exchange of ideas among participants. Research proposals must be within the proposed research lines of the conference.

The poster must be submitted for evaluation to ucc.flrc@ucc.mx.

Posters must contain the following elements: Title (maximum 20 words), name and affiliation of the author(s), including faculty and university, introduction (problem), objective(s), methodology, results, conclusion, references (APA 7). All images and graphs must state the source.

Posters must comply with the following characteristics:

- a) Poster design will rely on the creativity of the author(s), taking into account that the information provided should be clear, concise and with the aim of attracting the audience's attention.

- b) Size and font on the posters, pictures, charts or tables must be chosen by the author; however, font size ranging from 24 to 36 points is recommended.
- c) The orientation of posters will be vertical. Poster sizes will be downsized to 90 cm wide by 120 cm tall.
- d) Printing material will be tarpaulin (without rings), quality of text and images is highlighted.
- e) Poster presentations are exempt from the registration fee when the student is the first author.
